EASTER SUNDAY Christ is risen. Alleluia!

This Sunday as we celebrate the mystery of the Resurrection we proclaim our faith and hope and give thanks for these gifts.



Easter reminds us that every Good Friday in our lives will have an Easter Sunday, and that Jesus will let us share the power of his Resurrection. Each time we display our love of others, we share in the Resurrection. Each time we face a betrayal of trust and, with God's grace, forgive the betrayer, we share in the Resurrection of Jesus. Each time we fail in our lives and continue to hope – even when our hope seems unanswered – we share in the power of Jesus' Resurrection. The message of Easter is that nothing can destroy us – not pain, sin, rejection, betrayal or death – because Christ has conquered all these, and we, too, can conquer them if we put our faith and trust in Him.
