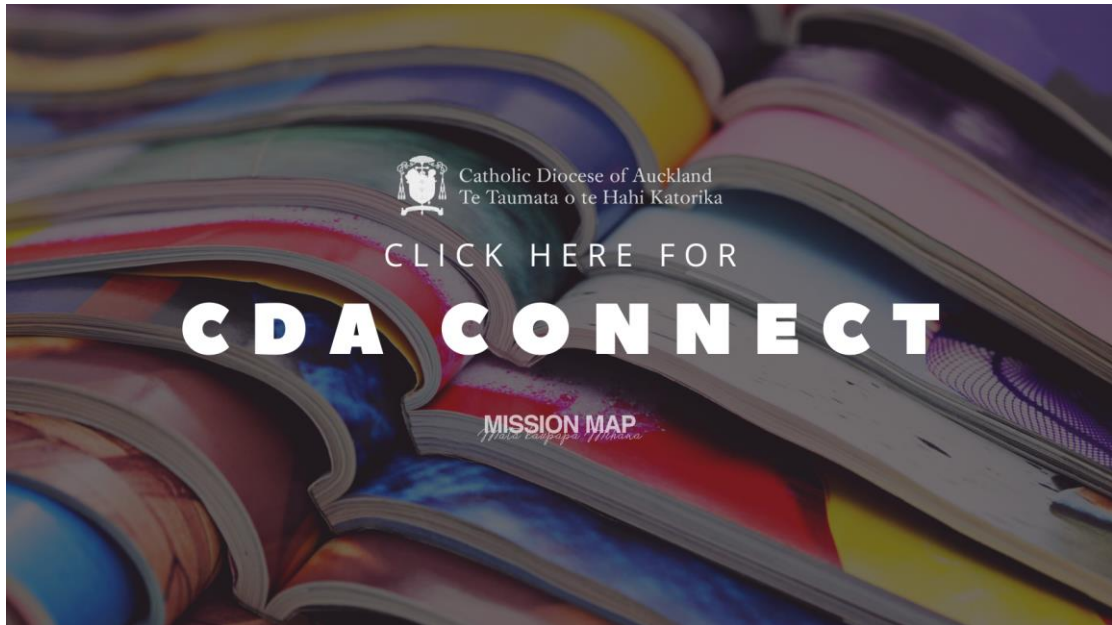
Opening of Diocesan phase of Synod
